Writing

This term, we will begin by using our letter writing skills to write letters of application for takeover day! We will then write a diary entry from a character's perspective before focussing on narrative writing using part of the story of 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas'. In Grammar, we will be focussing on choosing appropriate noun phrases to enhance description and recapping the use of apostrophes for possession.



Maths

This term's units will include:

- Ratio
- Area, Perimeter and Volume
- Shape

We will also be recapping many of the arithmetic skills which were taught in the Autumn term and this will be a focus within homework.

Computing

In computing this term, the children will be learning the basic principles of creating and maintaining a blog in a controlled and safe environment. They will also learn about history of the internet.

This term in DT we will be designing and creating a new school playground. The children will use a variety of materials to create their playground, as well as learning how to safely use a coping saw to cut dowel and jelutong.



History

In History this term, the children will be learning about World War 2. They will begin by plotting key events onto a class timeline and then they'll learn about some of the key events in further detail e.g. the Battle of Britain and The Blitz. They'll also learn about evacuation and the role of women.

Music

The focus this term in music performance. Throughout the term, children will learn to perform a song from memory, paying particular attention to rhythmic melody whilst working as part of an ensemble, and using instruments.



PE

PE days this term will be Mondays and Wednesdays. Mondays will be indoor sessions with a focus on badminton and Wednesdays will be an outdoor session, learning about Hockey!



PSHE

In PSHE this term, the children will be considering the positive and negative aspects of using computers and being online, including laws that have been created to protect us. They will also learn about in-app purchases and how this can and does, at times, lead to debt and feelings of worry.

RE

In RE, the focus will be on the work of charities. The children will compare and contrast aspects of religion in action and they will develop their understanding of community, relating what they learn to their own questions of value and commitment.

Year 6 are so excited for Takeover Day which will take place on Friday 10th March. The children will be writing their letters of application during the first week back after half term.
