Top Tips to encourage Summer Reading Challenge Finishers!

1. Award house points/ dojo's for bringing in a finishers certificate in September
2. Homework idea - Ask the children to review one of the books that they have read during the Summer Reading Challenge
3. Social Media - Corby Library will update their Facebook page weekly with the Schools leader board. Share this to your schools social media or your parent app.
4. Arrange a 'which class has the most finishers' competition
5. Before finishing for the Summer children could share their favourite book titles with their class to give others an idea of what they might read.
